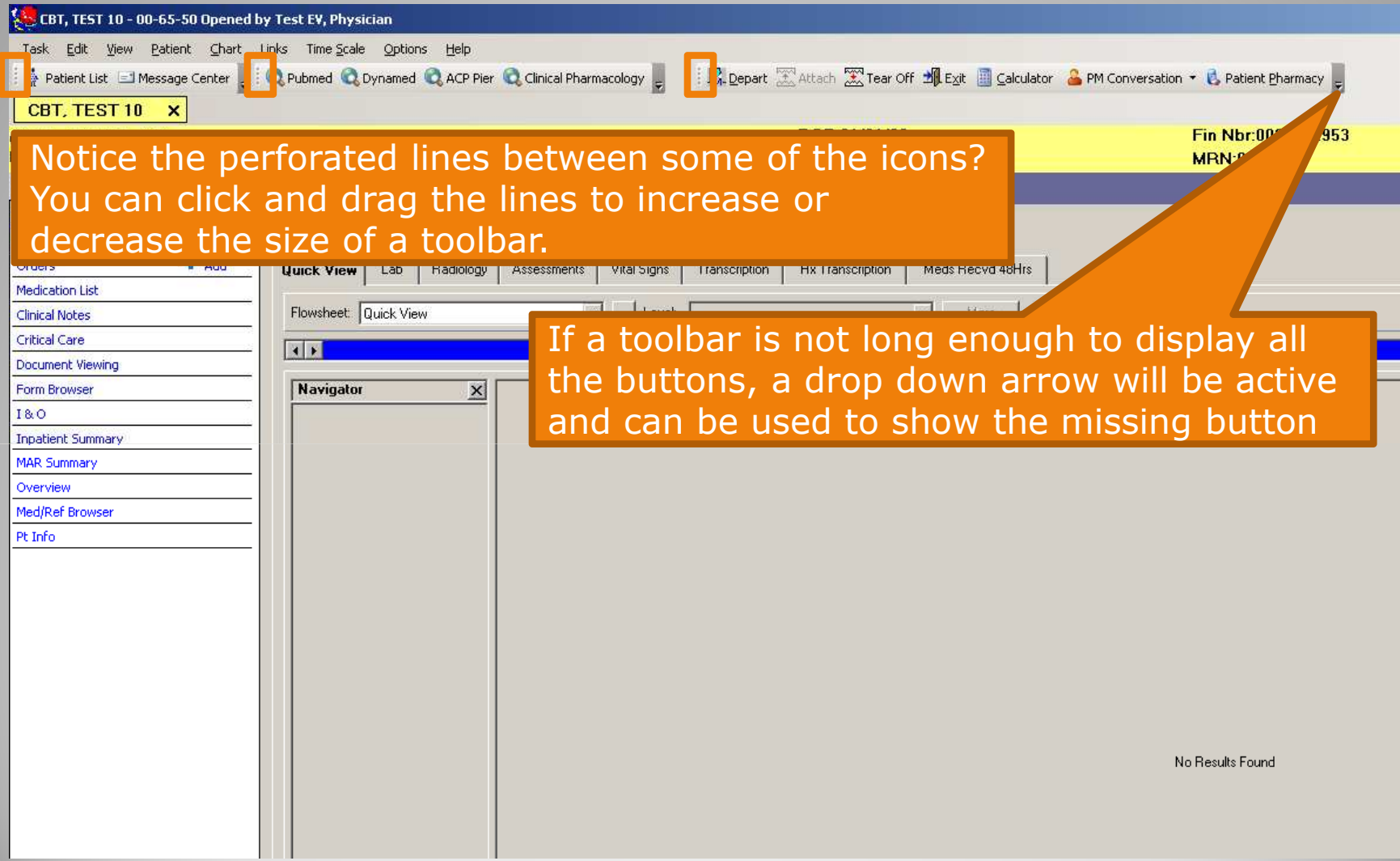

Enhanced View uses toolbar icons located across the top of the page that have a web-based feel.

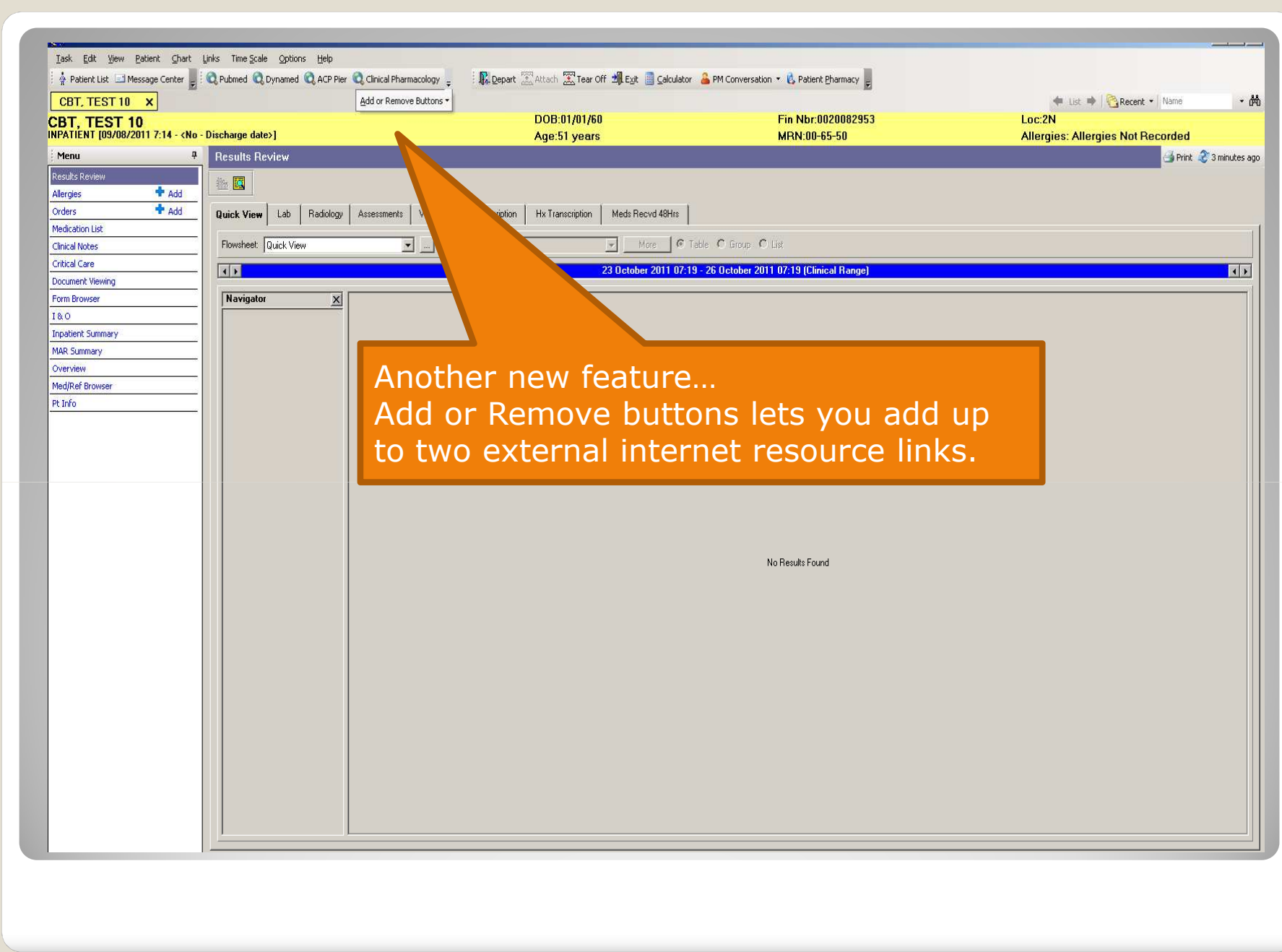

Notice the perforated lines between some of the icons? You can click and drag the lines to increase or decrease the size of a toolbar.

If a toolbar is not long enough to display all the buttons, a drop down arrow will be active and can be used to show the missing button



Another new feature...

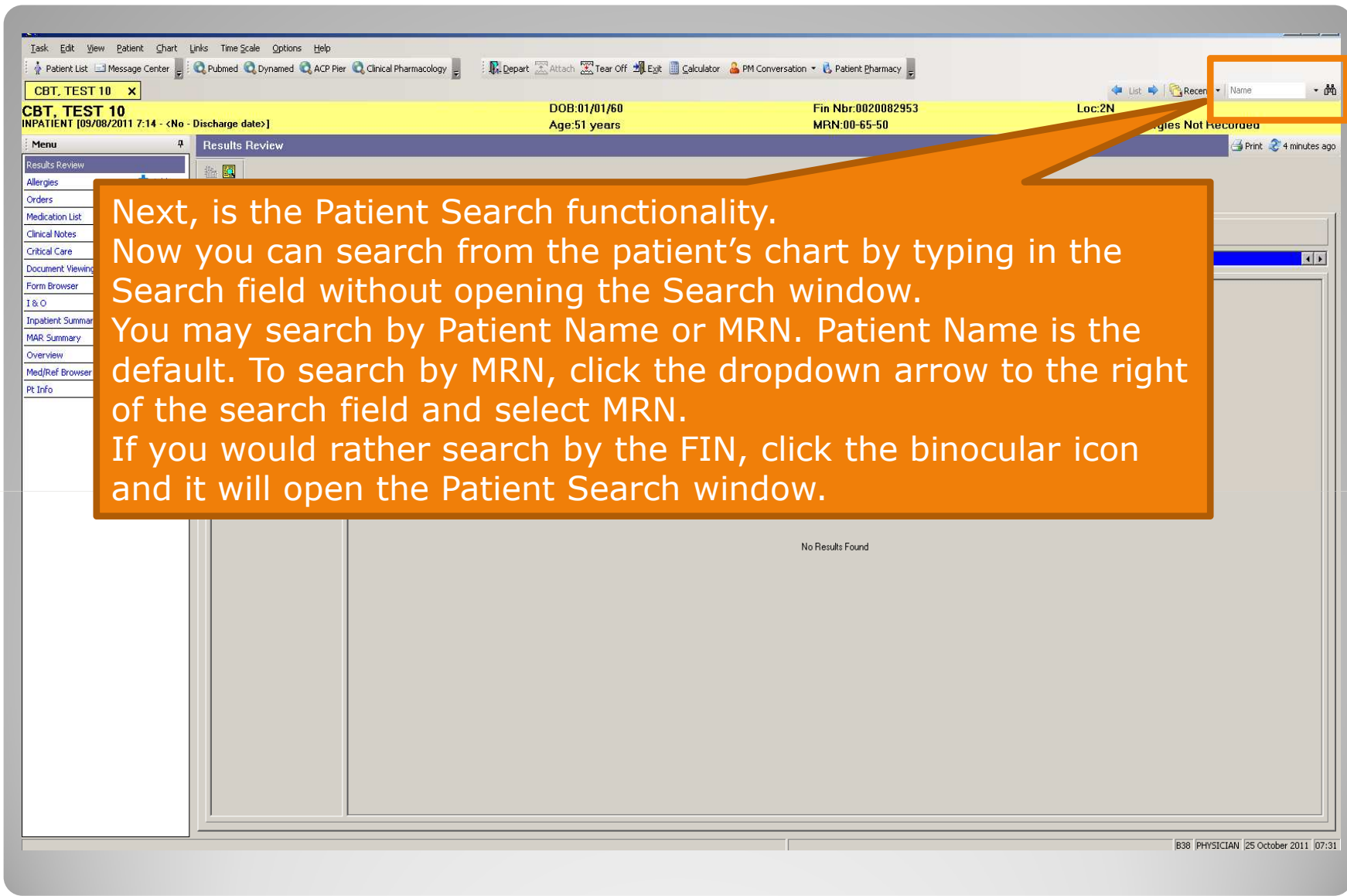

The arrows on the List button let you quickly access the previous and next patients on your Patient List

And you can view the 10 most recent charts you accessed by selecting the Recent icon



Next, is the Patient Search functionality. Now you can search from the patient's chart by typing in the Search field without opening the Search window. You may search by Patient Name or MRN. Patient Name is the default. To search by MRN, click the dropdown arrow to the right of the search field and select MRN. If you would rather search by the FIN, click the binocular icon and it will open the Patient Search window.

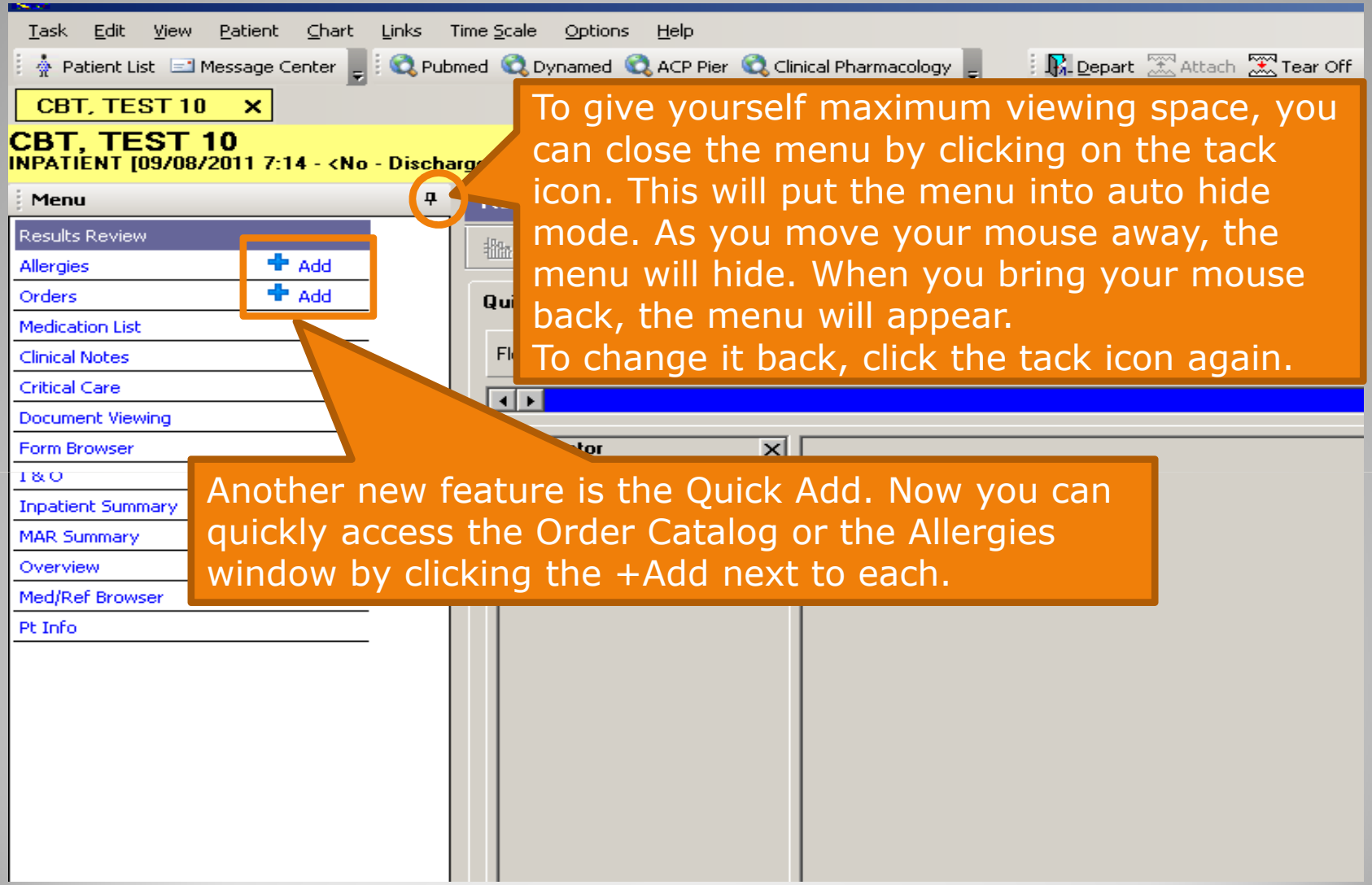

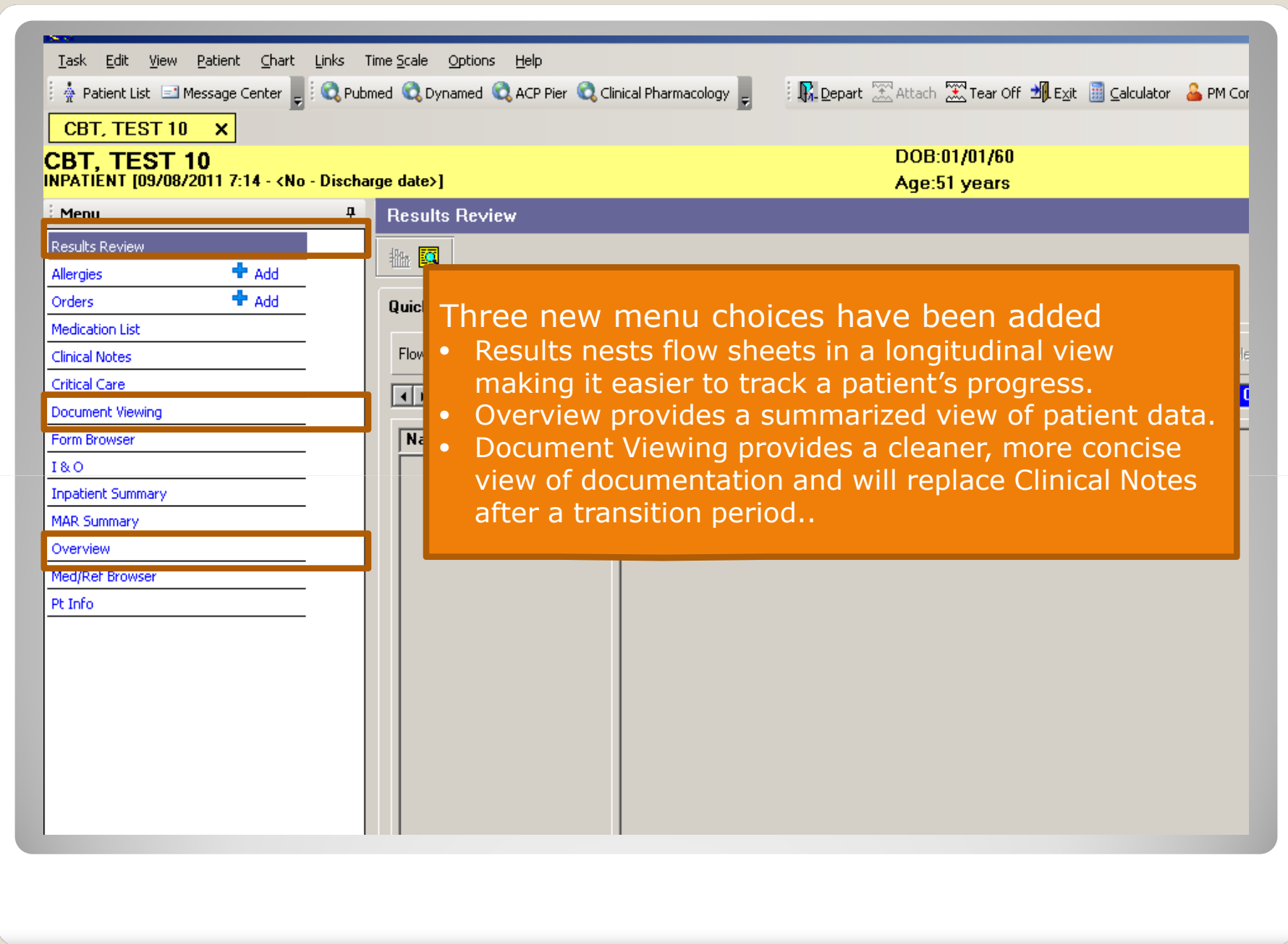

To give yourself maximum viewing space, you can close the menu by clicking on the tack icon. This will put the menu into auto hide mode. As you move your mouse away, the menu will hide. When you bring your mouse back, the menu will appear. To change it back, click the tack icon again.

Another new feature is the Quick Add. Now you can quickly access the Order Catalog or the Allergies window by clicking the +Add next to each.
