



NOTICE OF FACILITY FEES

You are receiving services in an Albany Medical Center Hospital (“Facility”) location. Because it is a Facility location, you may receive a bill from the Facility (the “Facility Fee”) as well as a separate bill for the professional service of any doctor you see today (the “Professional Fee”). The purpose of the Facility Fee is to cover the costs associated with your care that are attributed to the Facility (e.g., nurses, technicians, other non-physician staff, ancillary services, room, medications, equipment, and supplies, etc.) as opposed to the Professional Fee which represents the charge solely for the professional services provided by your doctor(s).

Depending on your agreement with your health plan you may be responsible separately for co-insurance, deductible or co-pay amounts and/or other out of pocket expenses that may be attributed to the Facility Fee. These patient responsibility amounts are determined by your health plan and are based on the services performed. These amounts may be different if you were to receive services at a health care provider location that is not considered a facility location by your health plan. Further, if Facility is not considered a participating provider with your health plan (Out-of-Network) you may be directly responsible for all or a portion of any Facility Fee.
